

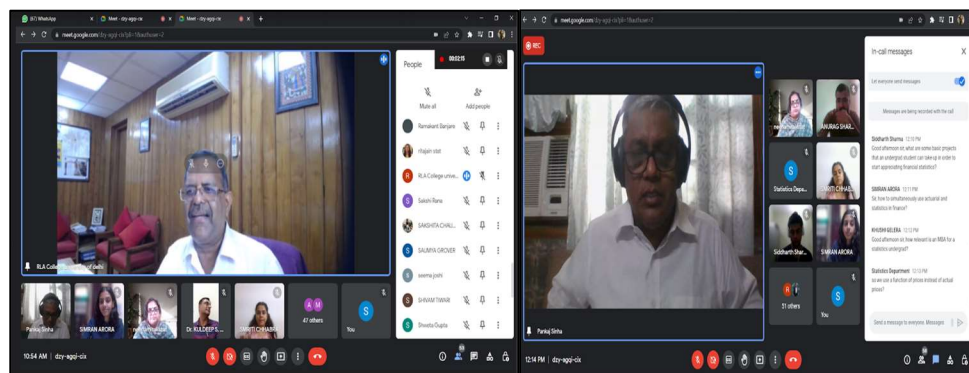

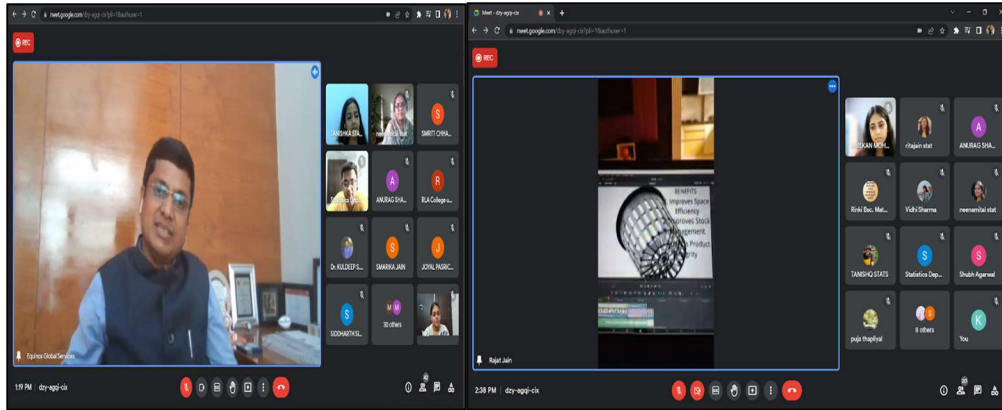
Students and teachers from the entire statistics department and many more showed enthusiasm and participated in the events.

RANDOM WALK'23

Panacea - the Statistics Society of Ram Lal Anand College celebrated its Annual intercollege festival - Random Walk'23 on the 5th and 6th April, 2023. The fest included a series of events that aimed to promote statistics among the students.

The festival began with a traditional lamp lighting ceremony followed by series of events.

These events allowed students to showcase their skills and knowledge in the field of statistics while providing a platform for healthy competition and fun. Winners were awarded with cash prizes and certificates. Exciting stall games were also arranged for the students of the College which was a great success. It concluded successfully with various exciting events that drew participation from students from all over Delhi University.

1. **GUEST SPEAKER SESSION:** Talk on 'Statistics in Medicine - Importance, Scope, and Challenges' by Dr. Vidhal Deo, Scientist at the ICMR – NIMS. He talked about the significance of statistics in medical science, the scope of various roles in this field, and the

challenges ahead. He made the session interactive by answering queries of the students patiently and shared anecdotes from his experience in academia.

2. **WORD WAR :** An offline turncoat debate competition The topics for the debate were •This house believes that Data Science is just a rebranding of Statistics.
•Encrypted user data: Privacy vs. National Security?
The event had 21 registrations and winners were 1st - **Himanshu Sharma of IGNOU** and 2nd - **Simran Arora of RLAC**.
3. **STATCHAT:** Statchat was a paper presentation competition. Theme-Application of statistical inference, sampling techniques, biostatistics, stochastic processing using empirical or real-life data. The participants submitted an abstract while registration. Total of 5 participants. Naman Manchanda from RLAC won the first position with his work on "Simple stochastic model for Covid 19." Ishaan, also from RLAC, secured the second position with his paper on "Prediction of election polls: Indian state election."
4. **STATDICT:** Statdict was an offline event aimed to test the statistical knowledge of the participants through a series of rounds. Total of 13 participants registered, 9 were selected for the final event after the preliminary rounds. Team Kurtosis emerged as the winner, with Mohd. Saqib Khursheed, and Aditya Verma from RLAC. The runner-up team was Team Jim, with Krishan Kant and Aryan Sharma from RLAC
5. **BETBALL:** An offline bidding event based on cricket prediction and auction. The event was conducted in 3 rounds. Total of 31 registrations were made and top 8 teams were selected for the final and mega auction round with a budget of ₹ 50 crore. Finally the teams with highly rated players and best budget optimization were selected as winners. 1st position was held by Vivek Kumar, Rohan Aswal and Satvik Dhaundiyal of RLAC and 2nd position was held by Ayush Singh and Baburaj Soren of Maharaja Agrasen College.
6. **Escapade:** A treasure hunt event in which the players were supposed to find a hidden prize by following special clues based on statistics spread across different places in the campus . 45 registrations were made for round 1 out of which top 16 teams were chosen for the final round. **Tamjeed** and **Rounak** of the BMS department were the winners.
