Sankalp'24 exemplified the spirit of community, creativity, and social responsibility, leaving a lasting impact on all who attended.

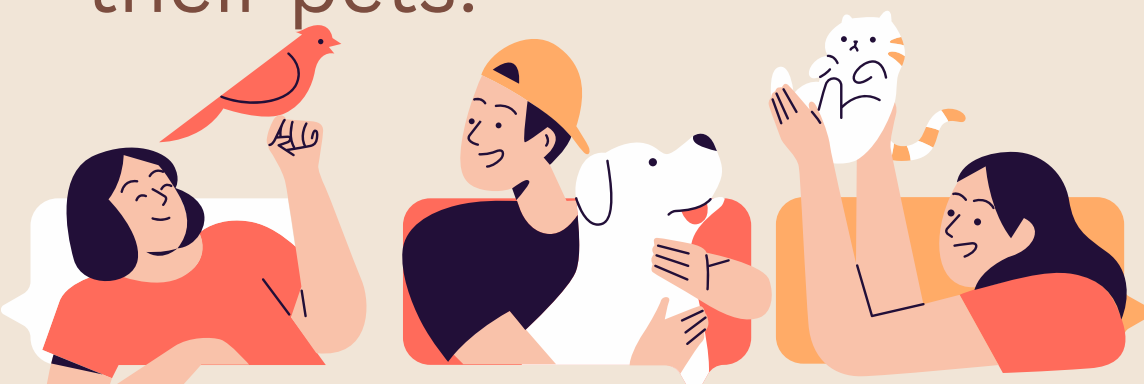


MAY ANNUAL REPORT

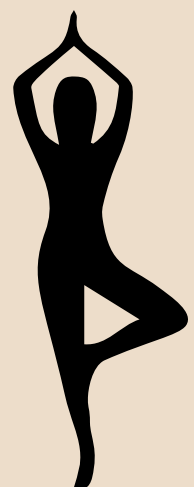
INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY

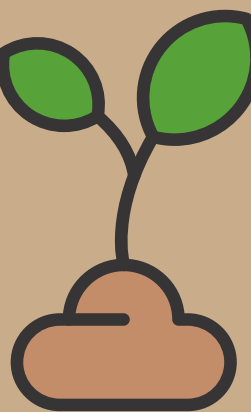
TREE PLANTATION DRIVE
