 - 1. Prof. Raj Kumar, Department of English University of Delhi.

Raj Kumar is Professor in the Department of English, Delhi University. His research areas include Autobiographical studies, Dalit literature, Indian writing in English, Odia literature and Post-colonial studies. He has been a Fellow at the Indian Institute of Advanced Study, Shimla in 1999 and has published in journals such as Social Action, Sateertha Bulletin, The Fourth World, Creative Forum, Language Forum, Jadavpur Journal of Comparative Literature, Indian Literature, Social Scientist, Journal of the School of Language, Literature and Culture Studies, International Journal of Communication, Rama Devi Women University Journal of Social Sciences and Humanities, International Journal of Religious Tourism and Pilgrimage, Ravenshaw Journal of Literary and Cultural Studies, Economic and Political Weekly, Studies in Humanities and Social Sciences, Journal of Comparative Literature and Aesthetics and Sociological Bulletin. Raj Kumar has also translated literary texts from Indian languages, especially Odia into English. His book, Dalit Personal Narratives: Reading Caste, Nation and *Identity* has been published by Orient BlackSwan, New Delhi in 2010 and got reprinted in 2011, 2015 and 2017. His English translation of Akhila Naik's **Bheda**, the first Odia Dalit novel is published by Oxford University Press, Delhi in 2017. His book Dalit Literature and Criticism is published by Orient BlackSwan, New Delhi in 2019.

2. Prof. P. Kesava Kumar, Head, Department of Philosophy, University of Delhi.

He received PhD from University of Hyderabad. He taught at Pondicherry University. He is specialized in social and political philosophy, contemporary Indian Philosophy, Continental Philosophy and Cultural Studies. He has published many papers in various journals.

3. Prof. Akshaya Kumar—Head of the Department of English and Cultural studies, Punjab University, Chandigarh.

He got critical attention for his book *Poetry, Politics and Culture* (Routledge, 2009) and his co-edited volume *Cultural Studies in India* (Routledge, 2016). He is writing *A Critical History of Punjabi Literature* –a project Commissioned by Orient Blackswan. His, another co-edited volume *Popular Culture in South Asian Context* is in Press and is about to be published by Routledge.

4. Prof. Parmod Kumar Mehra, Department of English, IGNOU.

Prof. Parmod Kumar Mehra is a multifaceted individual whose distinguished career as a Professor of English, prolific writer, translator, and dedicated social-entrepreneur have made him a revered figure. His contributions to the academic and community development spheres continue to inspire and uplift, making him a beacon of knowledge and social change.

 Dr. Dhurjatti Sarma, Dept of MIL and Literary Studies, Gauhati University. Dr. Sarma did PhD from EFLU Shilong. His area of interests includes Comparative Indian Literature, Literary Criticism and theory, India Studies and Critical Humanities.

6. Brief summary of the event

Prof. Raj Kumar spoke about the contribution of Mulk Raj Anand to English Literature. The lecture was designed to make the students familiar with Mulk Raj Anand. He was among the beginners who initiated the representation of marginalized subjects in Indian literature in the early twentieth century. His novel *Untouchable* speaks volume of caste discrimination practiced in Indian social order. Prof Kumar summarised the period between 1930s and 2024 in context of caste discourse. Prof. Kesava Kumar talked about Ngugi's contribution to Postcolonial Studies. He exposed how the dominant discourse controls the psyche of the marginalized subjects. Prof. Akshaya Kumar began with the idea of ideology and explained how it works in everyday social. How ideology functions as a "material practice" rather than merely a set of ideas. He explained the repressive and ideological state apparatuses. Prof. Pramod Mehra enlightened the students about the concept of world literatures and

how the Eurocentric approach was promoted through literature. He discussed how the Eurocentric approach can be contested by reading the local literature. Dr. Dhurjatti Sarma spoke about the nuances of translation. Translation across media, namely literature and cinema has opened up the world of art and creativity to a wider audience. The fusion of both these media has given rise to countless fascinating exploration of narratives. A number of our favourite movies have been adapted from or influenced by books, forming an intrinsic connection between the world of literature and cinema.

6. The event ended with feedback form and coupons for refreshments being circulated among participants



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










Report of Lecture on 'Understanding Althusser: State,Ideology, and Apparatus'



EVENT HIGHLIGHTS


- Students from various departments were present for the event.

5. The competition ended with feedback form and coupons for refreshments being circulated among participants.



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


