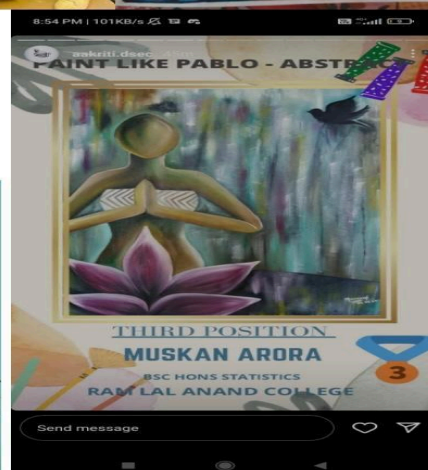
Sanjana Kumari secured 3rd position in Chitrakari Sketching Competition organized by Dyal Singh Evening College.

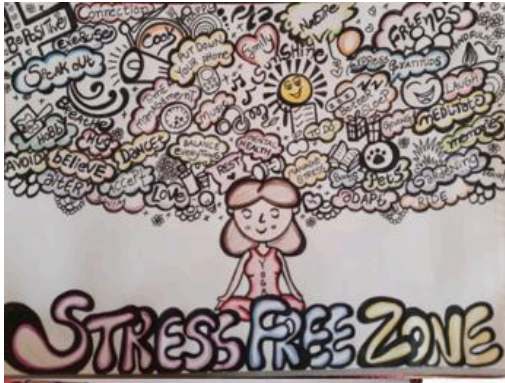

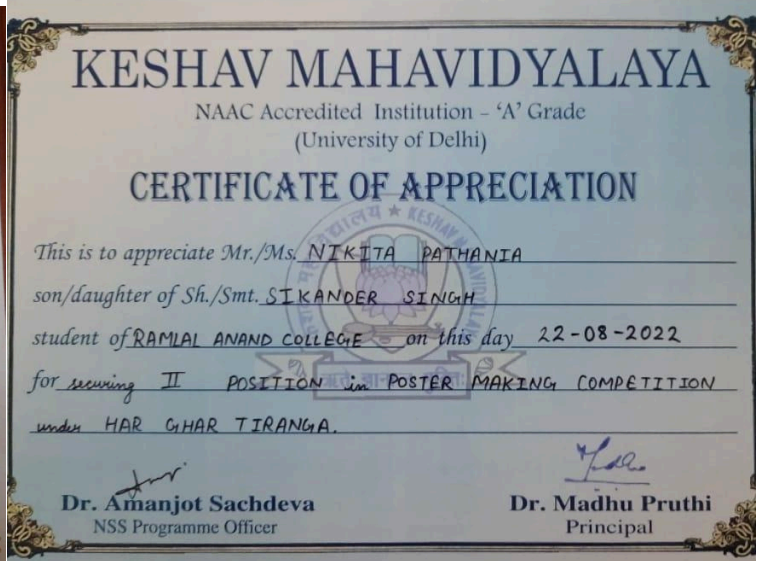
1. Gold for the \*Best Background Score for cinematography\* (individual specialization: music compositing)
