



<u>QUIZ COMPETITION</u>





WALKATHON













ELOCUTION COMPETITION






Poster Making Competition

Voter's Awareness Session







The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Ram Lal Anand Mahavidyalaya, in collaboration with the Electoral Literacy Club, organized a voter awareness session on January 28, 2025. The speaker, Shiv Chaudhary, SVEEP Advisor, addressed the issue of voter apathy, categorizing it into "Youth Apathy" (young adults over 18 who don't vote) and "Urban Apathy" (city dwellers who feel no need to vote). He highlighted the Voter Helpline App, which facilitates quick voter ID card creation, and discussed special provisions like Home Postal Voting for senior citizens and disabled individuals to ensure accessible voting. Chaudhary also detailed new Election Commission schemes. Following the speaker session, a podcast featuring District Election Officer Sanjay Kumar Singh encouraging voter participation was played. NSS Program Officer Dr. Anurag Sharma presented a plant to the speaker as a token of appreciation. The event saw participation from 80 volunteers, including 52 women.
