Call for Applications: Student Interns for Principal's Internship Scheme 2026-27 for a three month internship in Project “ **Nayi Soch: From Teaching to Learning**, *An initiative of Zydex Industries*, a learning movement born in the government primary schools of Vadodara, from a single district towards the whole of India under Dr. Jigar Inamdar, Chairman, Governing Body

About the Project: Nayi Soch is a corporate social responsibility initiative of Zydex Industries, conceived by its CEO, Dr. Ajay Ranka. It begins from a simple observation: our schools are very good at giving children information, and far less good at teaching them how to learn. The programme sets out to change this at the mid-primary level, while habits of mind are still forming. Working inside the government primary schools of Vadodara district, Gujarat, it does not add another subject to an already crowded timetable; instead, it changes how the classroom hour is used. Children learn a few new words each day, practise short memory and reasoning exercises, read against the clock and then explain in their own words what they have understood, and are asked, gently but regularly, to stand and speak. Teachers are supported to become “learning enablers” rather than lecturers, and character, discipline and empathy are given as much weight as academics. The method blends modern cognitive science, such as spaced repetition, retrieval practice and rapid reading, with India's own traditions of training the mind, and sits naturally within the spirit of NEP 2020. Proven now in Vadodara, it is ready to grow to the state level and, in time, across the nation.

Your Role: As an intern, you will help Nayi Soch make the leap from one district to many. Working through the programme's core areas of vocabulary, memory, comprehension and rapid reading, and thinking and originality, you will research, design and simplify the daily learning material so that any classroom, in any language, can pick it up and use it. You will help adapt content into Hindi and other regional languages, shape modules suited to different settings, from city schools to village schools where many children will go on to farm, and prepare clear toolkits, notes and a briefing on the method. You will also help design the roadmap for taking it wider: how the material reaches teachers, how the model is first piloted, then measured, and finally carried into new regions through local “chain makers.” Step by step, you will help turn a proven idea into a complete and usable programme that others can simply pick up and run.

What You Will Gain: Selected interns receive direct mentorship from Dr. Jigar Inamdar and hands on experience in research, curriculum and content design, translation and programme planning. They also see, from the inside, how a grassroots education reform is built, tested and scaled, gain exposure to the Nayi Soch team and the wider vision of Dr. Ajay Ranka.

Duration: Three months, extendable by a further three months if required.

Intake: 4 to 8 student interns will be selected.

Eligibility: **II and III year** students with a minimum CGPA of 7 of any discipline; Writing and Communication skills; teamwork abilities

How to Apply: Interested students are required to fill application form using the link: <https://forms.gle/GVfAAc59oxp9z5Qi7> and upload marksheet along with short statement of interest in about 150 words in a single document latest by 21.8.2026 at 5pm.

Stipend and Recognition: selected students will receive a stipend of INR 3000 per month and a Certificate of Internship from Principal on successful completion.

Selection: Shortlisted candidates will be notified through email and called for an interview. The Interview will be held on 22.08.2026/ 29.08.2026 in the college.
