Call for Applications: Student Interns for Principal's Internship Scheme 2026-27 for a three month internship in **Project Samskaar, A Community Education Movement, An initiative of Samanvay Pratishthan**) under the mentorship of **Dr. Jigar Inamdar, Chairman, Governing Body.**

About the Project: Samskaar, a Community Education Movement aims to strengthen civic sense across Bharat. The work is to build the teaching content and the plan that will carry the movement from an idea on paper into real practice. It is a chance to turn a national vision into something real and usable, to create material that could one day reach schools and citizens in every district, and to see your own work become part of a lasting people's movement. Samskaar rests on a simple pledge, Samaydanam, which means the gift of one hour a day. The movement works in two directions at once. The first is a free civic curriculum for schools from Grade 5 to Grade 9, taught mainly through video. The second is a wider effort across society, built around a Civic Sense Education Centre in every district, a citizens' certificate course, and a body of volunteers that reaches from the state right down to every village and ward. At its heart lie eleven practical life themes. These cover community health and sanitation; emergency response and first aid; road safety; civic conduct and the duties of citizenship; local governance and civic participation; digital responsibility and financial literacy; consumer rights and grievance redressal; care for the environment and water; gender sensitivity and the safety of women; mental wellness and recovery from addiction; and family values and social harmony. As an intern, you will help build the substance of the movement. Working through the eleven themes one by one, you will research and prepare detailed content that is ready to teach and suited to different age groups and levels of learning. You will also help design a clear and practical roadmap for putting it all into effect: how the content reaches learners, how district centres and volunteers are organised, and how the movement is first piloted, then measured, and finally scaled. Step by step, you will help turn an idea of eleven themes into a complete and usable programme that others can simply pick up and run.

What You Will Gain: Selected interns receive direct mentorship from Dr. Jigar Inamdar and hands on experience in curriculum and content design, research, and programme planning. They also see, from the inside, how a genuine nation building initiative takes shape. Strong performers may be invited to continue for a further three months, and to be credited in the movement's materials.

Duration: Three months, extendable by a further three months if required.

Intake: 4 to 8 student interns will be selected.

Eligibility: **II and III year** students with a minimum CGPA of 7 of any discipline; Writing and Communication skills; teamwork abilities

How to Apply: Interested students are required to fill application form using the link: <https://forms.gle/GVfAAc59oxp9z5Qi7> and upload marksheet along with short statement of interest in about 150 words in a single document latest by 21.8.2026 at 5pm.

Stipend and Recognition: selected students will receive a stipend of INR 3000 per month and a Certificate of Internship from Principal on successful completion.

Selection: Shortlisted candidates will be notified through email and called for an interview. The Interview will be held on 22.08.2026/ 29.08.2026 in the college.
