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Principal's Report

Good Morning Everyone!

It's a proud moment for me to welcome the distinguished guests, all my teaching and non-teaching colleagues, and my dear students to the 54th Annual Day of Ram Lal Anand College, which is a celebration of our faculty and student's achievements in the year going by.

We are honored to have with us our esteemed Chief Guest, Air Marshall Shri Naresh Verma, AVSM, VSM (Retd), Director, India International Centre.

Sh. Naresh Verma ji is a highly decorated officer with AVSM (Ati Vishishth Seva Medal) and VSM (Vishishth Seva Medal). During his forty years of service in the Administrative Branch of the Indian Air Force, he held several assignments with responsibilities related to Infrastructure Development, Project Management, Education, Legal Matters, Financial Management, Human Resource Management and Development, Welfare, Sports and Adventure and even Catering. He was the Chief Administrative Officer at four premier Air Force Stations, Principal Director of Works at Air Headquarters and head of Administration (SOA) of two Air Force Commands. He was promoted to the rank of Air Marshal and appointed the first Director-General of Administrative Branch and later appointed as the Air Officer In-charge of Administration of the Indian Air Force.

He is an alumnus of the reputed National Defence College, New Delhi. He was appointed as Hon'ble Member of the Armed Forces Tribunal, Regional Bench, Chandigarh, a post which he relinquished after two years on his appointment as Director, India International Centre. He was also the elected President of Delhi Gymkhana Club for two years.

He is currently the honorary Member, Governing council of Indian Council of World Affairs, Member, Advisory Council, Shemford Doon School, Dehradun, Member, National Advisory Board, SPIC-MACAY, Member, General Body, Council for Social Development (CSD) New Delhi and Member, Governing Body, Ram Lal Anand College

His perseverance, far-sightedness and vast administrative knowledge and experience makes him a true role model and a guiding force for all of us. Sir, we are fortunate to have your constant guidance as a member of Governing Body of the college.

I also heartily welcome Honorable Shri Brij Kishore Sharma, Chairman Governing Body.

Shri Brij Kishore Sharma, was the only student who had successfully completed his LLM from Lucknow University in 1959. He spent a decade in educating and training law students in Lucknow and Rajasthan Universities. He was selected for **Indian Law Services** where he made significant contributions working under various capacities. He is an ardent writer and has authored many books on the Constitution in both Hindi and English. He has also been the chair of the Copyright Board and National Book Trust. He has been felicitated by the states of Bihar, MP, Karnataka and Delhi for his services to Indian languages and also by the Ministry of Law and MHRD, for some of his books. Presently he is the **Chairman of Raja Rammohan Roy Library Foundation, an initiative of the Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India**. He has an excellent command over both English and Hindi, and has been a true source of inspiration to our faculty and students.

Our College has greatly benefitted from your guidance, encouragement and support which is evident from its linear growth and development profile during the last year.

Sir, we are indeed honoured by your gracious presence on our Annual Day.

I warmly welcome Prof Binay Kumar, Member Governing Body and Professor at the Department of Physics and Astrophysics. Professor Binay Kumar is an eminent Scientist with more than 60 research papers in high impact International refereed Journals. As I have known him, he is a person of very high moral and ethical values and has a kind personality. His contribution towards the development of college as member GB has been immense and is highly appreciable.

We also have amidst ourselves Hon'ble **Dr. R.M. Kohli**, our previous Chairperson, Governing Body. He is a reputed scholar and a renowned educationist. Dr. Kohli is the former Principal of Shyam Lal College, Delhi University. Dr. Kohli has been a guiding spirit ever since he has been associated with the College. He is a source of inspiration for all of us and it is a privilege to welcome him today.

Now, I take great pleasure in presenting the Annual Report of our college for the session 2017-2018.

Ram Lal Anand College was established in 1964 by Eminent Lawyer of the Supreme Court of India and a Great Visionary **Shri Ram Lal Anand Ji**. It started with just two pass courses, B.A. and B.Com. and now offers **fourteen** Undergraduate courses in all the three streams, i.e. Humanities, Commerce and Science and **One** PG course in Hindi. **Two** new courses, **B.A. (Hons) Mathematics** and **Bachelor of Management Studies (BMS)** have been successfully introduced in this academic session. Our college is fully funded by the UGC and is maintained by the University of Delhi.

During the academic session 2017-18, **732** students were admitted to different courses and a total of **1987 students** are currently enrolled in all the three years put together.

I briefly present before you, the academic achievements of the college in this session.

At the end of 2017, **766** students appeared in the University final year examinations. I am very happy to report that the pass percentage was **93.6%** (717) out of which more than **64 %** students obtained 1st division and **27%** obtained IInd division. It is a moment of pride for all of us to report that **Nitin Kumar Khandelwal** of B.Sc (Hons.) Geology has been awarded Gold medal in the University Convocation for being the Topper of University of Delhi in 2017.

A number of students of the college have received academic scholarships/fellowships from prestigious Institutions. Five students Pavni Sharma and K M Ambika from Microbiology and Dependra Singh, Vishal Saini and Rishabh Kumar from Geology are INSPIRE Fellows receiving Rs 80,000/- per annum scholarship from Department of Science and Technology. I would like to specially mention Shreya Uttam of B. A. (Hons) II year who has received an Educational Scholarship of Rs 20,000 from **World Brotherhood Organisation**. Y Yoshi from Microbiology is the recipient of PM Trophy Merit Scholarship from SAIL. **Two** of our students, Shravya Srivastav and Anisha Singh of Geology have received the **Science**

Academics summer Research Fellowships. Five Students from North East (Lucy, Horan, Amir, Rahul and Ronald) have received **Ishan Uday Scholarship from UGC.**

The college also provides financial assistance to needy and academically deserving students in the form of fee concession. A total of **Rs 2,30,000/-** has been distributed among **143** students as financial aid in this academic session. Twenty three students have been selected for Full fee concession from Delhi Government.

This year we have taken several new steps to promote a strong research culture in college and to give exposure to students for research. It's a pleasure for me to share that a total of 26 Innovation Research proposals were submitted to Research Council, University of Delhi for funding, by the faculty of our college this year. The college also submitted Proposal for Grants under DBT Star College Scheme to DBT. Another Research Proposal entitled "**Betel Nut Chewing Induced Genotoxic Changes–Evaluation and Awareness Study in Young Population of North Eastern State of India**" submitted by Dr Perna Diwan as PI and myself and Dr Kusum Gupta as Co-PI was successfully approved for funding of Rs 8.00 lakhs for one year by the Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Govt. of India. Two more Proposals for Skill Development courses have been submitted to DBT from Department of Microbiology and Statistics.

In this session, our faculty has published more than 18 **research papers/articles** in highly reputed and refereed journals. Seven faculty members have published their **books with renowned publishers.** Faculty members have **presented research papers** in more than 71 National and International Seminars, Conferences and Workshops. One of our faculty members, **Dr. Parul Gaur** from Department of History was invited to present a paper "Sports- Probing the Boundaries" in an **International Conference** at Vienna, Austria.

Dr Rakesh Kumar, Teacher In charge, Department of Hindi, received an **award "Vikas ke Satat Saathi Puraskaar" 2017-18 from Dabur Ayurved.** One of his PhD Students has been awarded PhD degree and another has submitted thesis this year.

Dr. Pradeep Kumar has been awarded **PhD degree** in August 2017 from JJT University, Rajasthan.

I would like to take this opportunity to brief you about the key developments and new initiatives taken by the college during the year.

With the dedicated efforts of Infrastructure Committee, a number of infrastructural projects such as **Renovation of Library** and **College administrative and accounts office** are near completion. The college campus has been made completely wi-fi enabled. Microbiology labs are equipped with advanced instruments viz. bench top fermenter and a UV spectrophotometer. Now RLA has become the only college in DU having a fermenter for teaching Industrial Microbiology. The construction of two class rooms and one big lecture hall has been planned and will start soon.

The college is meticulously and strictly following the rules of financial transparency and Governance. It has registered itself at GeM portal for all kinds of purchases and doing all transactions digitally as mandated by GOI. In addition, the college has established this year

an IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell) to ensure Academic and Administrative quality and Efficiency.

The new education policy of Government of India mandates for introduction of skill development courses in higher educational institutes in partnership with Industries. In order to fulfill this mandate, a skill enhancing 6 months **certificate course in “Heritage and Tourism Management”** has been started by the college. This course has been initiated in collaboration with Nijhawan Group of companies, pioneers of travel and tourism Industry by signing a MoU. The college is highly grateful to Mr Ankush Nijhawan, Director of the group and Ms Lalita Nijhawan, Member GB for participating in this programme as Industry partner. Another **certificate course** of 6 days **“Analytics using R”** was offered to the students in collaboration with Step Up Analytics.

The college has installed LCD projectors in its class rooms to promote interactive teaching using ICT tools. A **Faculty Development Programme** entitled “1st ICT workshop on Microsoft Excel and Power point” was organised for faculty of the college. 16 faculty members participated and benefitted from the programme.

Two new centres were established in the college:

A. Centre for Education and Training in Disaster Management. The objectives of the centre are to promote awareness among students to deal with disasters, training students to seek career opportunities and make them brand ambassadors to spread awareness among public about Disaster prevention, management and rehabilitation. This centre organized two seminars cum awareness programme on disaster management, Disaster Response and Mitigation and road safety in association with NIDM, NDRF and Traffic Police of Delhi. A certificate course will soon be launched in the next session in association with NIDM and NDRF.

B. Center for Entrepreneurship and Technology Development is aimed to enrich and sharpen the entrepreneurial skills of students who wish to establish and successfully run their own enterprises in future. This centre has organised many seminars/workshops on challenges and risks of starting new enterprises by inviting CEOs from many start ups and established companies. Mr Arnab Chakraborty, National Director, UNCTAD-Empretec Programme for India, guided students on Entrepreneurial skills. The college is highly grateful to Sh P P Shrivastav and Ms Lalita Nijhawan, members GB for agreeing to be the advisors of these centres.

A number of placement drives were conducted for the students by CCPC of the college. Big companies like Amazon, Tech Mahindra, KPMG, Smart Schools Inc Ltd. conducted interviews and a total of 160 students were offered jobs. One of our NCC cadets Amardeep Kaushik got 4th rank in direct entry to Armed forces as lieutenant. A Soft skill Assessment and Development of 3rd Year Students was also done by Abbscissa HR Consultants Pvt Ltd. An Internship Fair was organised in the college in which 18 companies participated and selected 300 students for summer internships. A three day workshop on career opportunities in today’s world and preparedness strategies was also organised inviting professional career counsellors.

The college Alumni Association was first time formed by electing its office bearers. Very soon it will be registered.

Education is incomplete without instilling good human values, life skills and sensitivity towards various sections of the society. The GB of the college advised us to start a Monthly Lecture Series in this direction. The Society Sangosthi organised lectures on current issues like GM crops, IPR, Constitution and Justice by eminent personalities like Prof Deepak Pental, Ex Vice Chancellor, University of Delhi, Dr R C Aggarwal, Registrar General, Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmer's Rights Authority, GOI, Prof B T Kaul, Chairman, Delhi Judicial Academy.

The Women's Welfare society organised one week Self Defence Programme for girls along with lectures on gender sensitization and cyber security.

Yoga and Meditation Committee organised several events including a three day Workshop on the occasion of International Yoga Day followed by a three weeks Yoga Workshop and one day meditation workshop. Department of Physical Education organised physical fitness assessment sessions and workshops for students and staff.

Gandhi Study Circle organised competitions and lectures to imbibe Gandhian thought and values among students. Prof Ramesh Bhardwaj, Director, Gandhi Bhawan delivered a talk on the issue. Rs 55000/- has been sanctioned by Gandhi Smriti and Darshan to conduct a National Seminar at the college.

North East Society actively worked to promote integration of students from North East with students from other states. Mr M P Bezbaruah (IAS Retd. and Chairperson of Bezbaruah Committee for safety and integration of North East Students) motivated students to understand and accept each other. College hosted 50 students from Sikkim for a day under "Ek Bharat Shreshth Bharat" initiative of Govt of India. Our sincere thanks to Sh P P Shrivastav, Member, GB for being the advisor of this committee.

Students were sensitized towards the deteriorating environment through lecture series and awareness campaigns by Eco Club. Eminent Environmentalists Mr Bharat Dogra, Prof Radhey Shayam Sharma, Principal Scientist A Arunachalam inspired and guided students about various aspects of protection of our Environment. The film Society "Parda" screened films allowing students to think and break the stereotype thoughts and behaviour. EOC played an important role in spreading the message and teachings of Baba Saheb Ambedkar among students of our college.

I am overjoyed to report that our faculty and students are **very conscious and enthusiastic** towards the **fulfilment of their social responsibilities**. NSS and NCC units organised cleanliness drives, Election awareness drive, Tree Plantation, Clothes Donation, Blood Donation Camp, awareness talk on Spinal Cord and sports Injuries. The NSS, NCC and Student Union volunteers participated in various activities and events, such as International Yoga day, Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat, Sankalp Se Siddhi (New India Movement 2017-2022), Khelo India Games, International Book Fair and Anti-drug campaign. NSS volunteer, Shivani Negi, B.A. (Hons.) III year student was selected among ten students from DU to participate in 22nd National Youth Festival (NYF) 2018, held at Gautam Buddha University, Greater Noida, UP. On the occasion of Republic Day, the NCC Guard Team of our college offered Guard of Honour at VC office while Vice Chancellor of Delhi University, Professor

Yogesh K Tyagi hoisted the National Flag. Our NCC cadets have participated in camps like ThalSainik, Advanced Leadership, National Integration, Trekking and Army Attachment.

We now come to the Special Events conducted during the year:

An Open House Session for aspirants seeking admission at UG level in the colleges of University of Delhi was held in the college on 12th June 2017. More than 300 students and parents turned up to get guidance about various courses and admission procedure in Delhi University. During this event Prof. Rajesh Tandon, Dean Students Welfare, Dr Amrita Bajaj and Dr Tuteja, Deputy Dean, addressed the students.

Centralized Trials of students for UG admission in Delhi University Colleges under quota for Extra-curricular activities in NCC and NSS were conducted in the college on behalf of University of Delhi.

Annual Cultural Festival ‘Nexplora-2018’ was organised by Students Union Advisory Committee in association with Arts and Culture Society on 16th and 17th February 2018. This event was vibrant and colourful and showcased the outstanding talent of the students of the University of Delhi in various competitions like **music, dance, slam poetry, quiz, debate, photography, street play** etc. The office Bearers of Student Union and Art and Craft society ‘Inara’ needs special mention who worked hard to make this event successful and memorable one. Two students Shreya Uttam and Apoorva Singh have shown excellent performance at various inter-college/inter-university competitions of debate, creative writing, slam poetry and poem recitation. Together they have won more than 15 prizes. Two students of Quizteros society, Nishant Agarwal and Gaurang Sharma deserve special mention as they participated in more than 50 quizzes, at college, inter-college or national level and have been awarded more than 20 1st or 2nd prizes.

54th Annual Sports Prize Distribution Function was celebrated as an awareness Campaign for Health, Fitness and wellness. Students who participated and brought laurels to the college in various sports were awarded. **I am happy to report that four of our students have represented at the National level in Ball Badminton and one in Cricket.**

All the departments in the college actively organized many **seminars/workshops** to promote innovative ideas and research culture and to keep the students updated about the recent advances in their respective fields. Eminent Personalities and academicians were invited to deliver talks to enrich the knowledge of Students and Faculty Members. Being a long list of events, a few are being mentioned here. **Department of Microbiology** organized for the first time a one day **International Seminar** on “**Infectious Diseases: Current Strategies for Diagnosis and Therapy**” with speakers from France, Belgium and USA. The Department of Computer Science, History, BJMC and Hindi organised one day National Seminars.

Field trips were conducted for students of various departments to give an added experience that they never could have had in the classroom which goes beyond reading about a concept. This year students were taken to various Institutions or sites of academic excellence in Mussorie, Shimla, Jaipur, Udaipur, Jim Corbett National Park, Rishikesh, Nainital, Yakult

plant, Sonapat, ABP News, Film City Noida, Dabur Ayurved Research Centre, Ahmedabad and various Heritage sites.

SPIC MACAY RLA Chapter organized a musical concert by one of the most renowned Santoor Maestro, Shri Abhay Rustom Sopori. The amphitheatre was full to the capacity to experience a spell bound instrumental music session.

NAAC Steering Committee of the college has successfully submitted the **SSR for NAAC Accreditation** and is awaiting the NAAC evaluation committee for qualitative assessment.

I sincerely appreciate the efforts of the Editorial team both faculty and students for bringing out such a wonderful college magazine ‘Samdrishthi which will be released soon.

I greatly acknowledge the Discipline Cum Anti Ragging Committee that worked throughout the year to maintain discipline and a peaceful environment in the college.

I would like to extend my gratitude towards teaching and non-teaching colleagues for their unstinted support and cooperation without which any of the above achievements would not have been possible.

I also appreciate and convey my sincere thanks to the Function Committee which has worked diligently and tirelessly to organise this function and to the Student Award Committee to decide Best Students of the year.

I would also like to extend my deep sense of gratitude towards the Chairman and all the members of Governing Body for their able guidance and advice throughout the year and entrusting upon me the responsibility to lead the college as its 5th Principal.

In the end, I congratulate and give best wishes to our two Best Students, one from sciences and other from Humanities and all the students who have excelled in academics and are about to receive prizes today.
