



ACTION TAKEN REPORT

presented on 11 July 2018

1. The information for feedback submission was sent to students via sms and so far 305 students have filled and submitted the general feedback form and 150 students have submitted the feedback on curriculum at the end of session 2017-18.
2. More Focus was given on career counselling and placement as recommended by IQAC. A number of placement drives were conducted in academic session 2017-18 for the students by CCPC of the college. Big companies like Amazon, Tech Mahindra, KPMG, Smart Schools Inc Ltd. conducted interviews and a total of 160 students were offered jobs. A Soft skill Assessment and Development of all 3rd Year Students and I year students of BMS was also arranged by Abbscissa HR Consultants Pvt Ltd. An Internship Fair was organised in the college in which 18 companies participated and selected 300 students for summer internships. A three day workshop on career opportunities in today's world and preparedness strategies was also organised inviting professional career counsellors. College also signed a MoU with CALYXPOD Talent Solutions Pvt. Ltd. on 1st December 2017, to manage placement/internship schedules and records
3. College has made provision to provide Computer and Internet facility to students in room no 15 (earlier 16) after 2pm on all working days.
4. Area outside canteen is being developed to increase the seating capacity and a kiosk for coffee/snacks and Mother Dairy Booth is being started to provide some healthy options to students and staff.
5. Governing Body has approved the proposals for M.A. English, M.Sc Statistics and M.Com in its meeting held on 29.6.18 and will now be sent to University for further approval.
6. Update on Extramural Funding and Research Activities: A Research Proposal submitted by Dr Purna Diwan, Dr Rakesh Kumar Gupta and Dr Kusum Gupta was successfully approved for funding of Rs 8.00 lakhs for one year by the Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Govt. of India.

The Online registration forms and online fee payment options have been made available on website. So far 95 registrations have been done.
 8. Two Add-on certificate courses “Heritage and Tourism Management” and “Analytics Using R-language” recommended by IQAC in its last meeting were successfully conducted. Another short term course for seven days on Data Science and Programming with PYTHON language for 60 hrs in 7 days was conducted for students. A five day FDP on Hadoop was also organised in association with ICT Academy with 40 participants from different colleges of DU and other universities.
 9. Mentors were assigned in all departments and a report of the same has been received by some departments and for the rest is being sought.
 10. Update on College’s NAAC Accreditation process status: The College submitted SSR to NAAC (following the IIQA approval) in online mode on 5th January 2017. NAAC has sought some clarifications from the college, which are being taken care off. The NAAC visit for Qualitative Assessment is expected soon.

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
