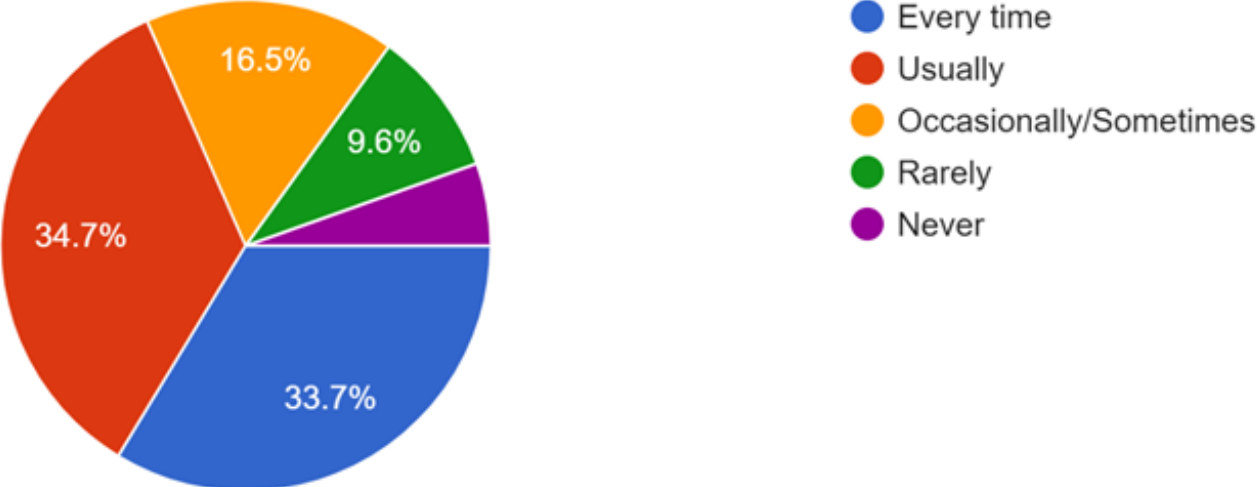

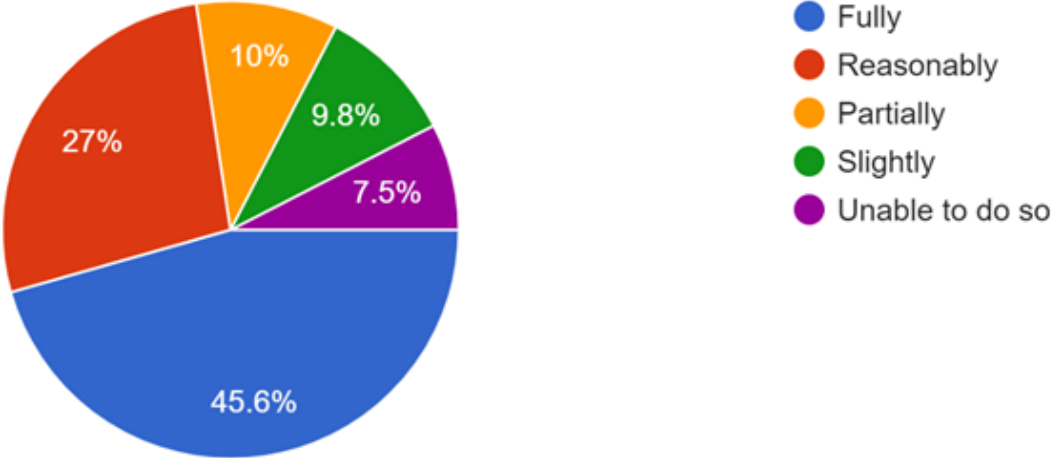
Q1: How well were the teachers able to communicate through online classes?



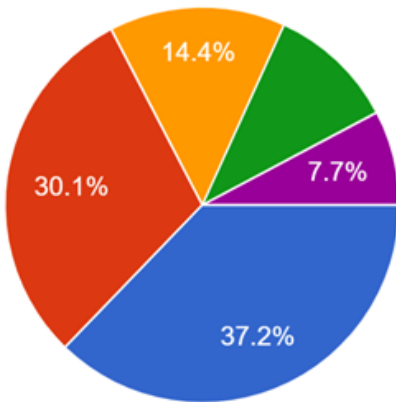
Q2: The teachers illustrate the concepts through power-point presentation/videos giving sufficient examples and applications



Q3: The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you by providing right level of guidance

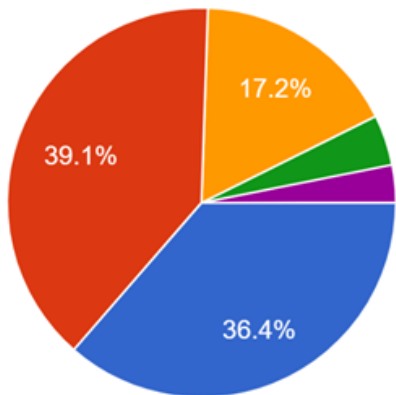


Q4: Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.



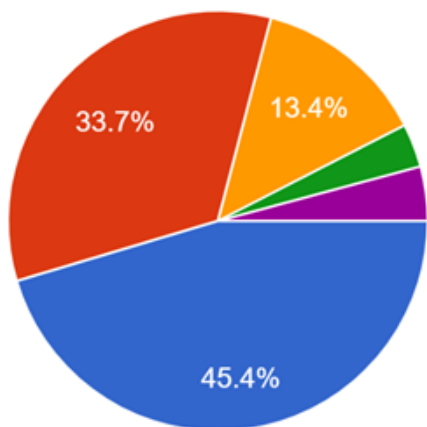

Q5: Teachers encourage you to participate in online/offline extracurricular/co-curricular activities.



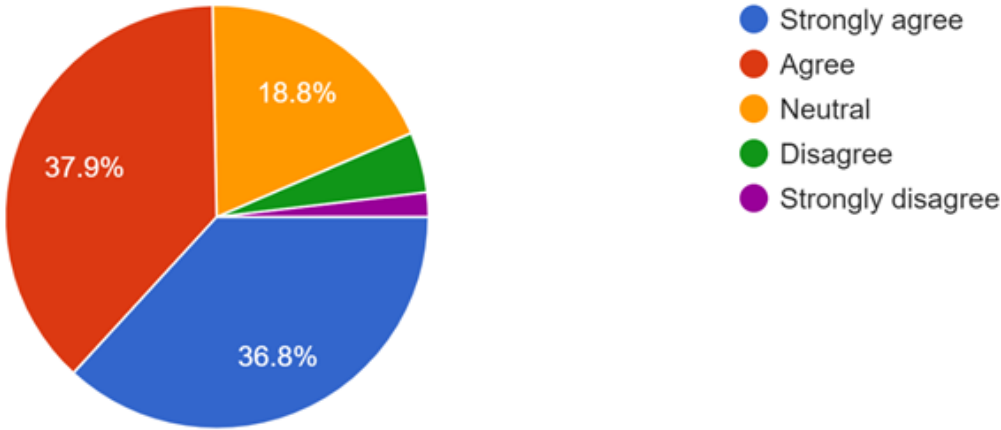

Q6: Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

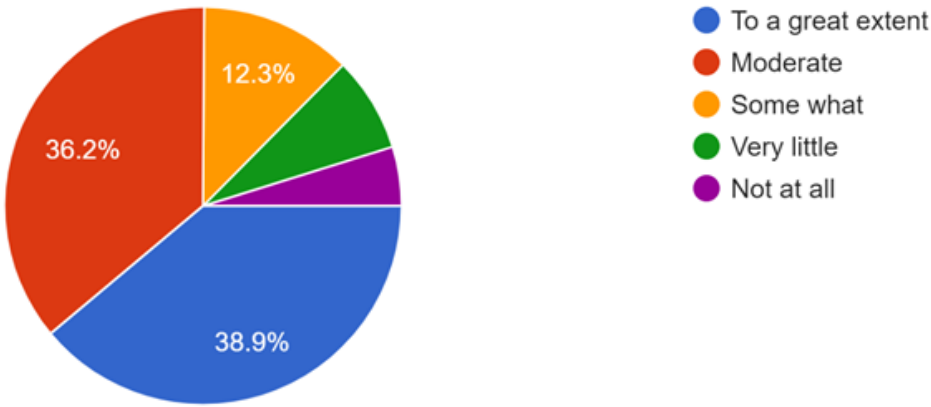

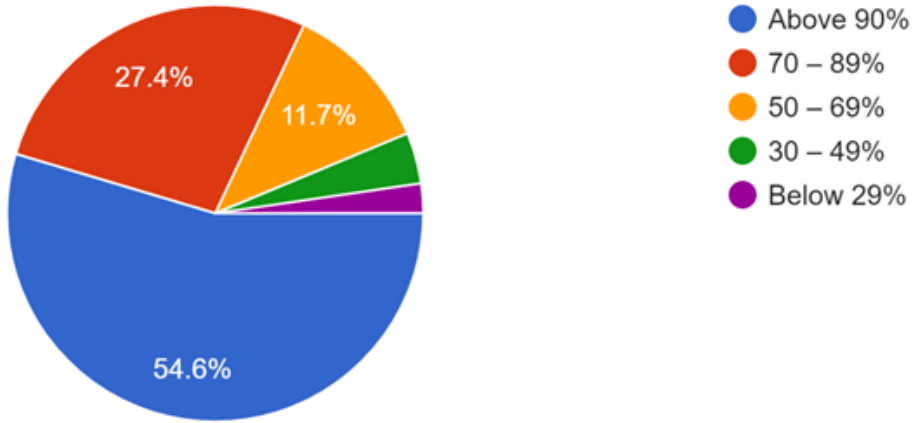
Q7: The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.



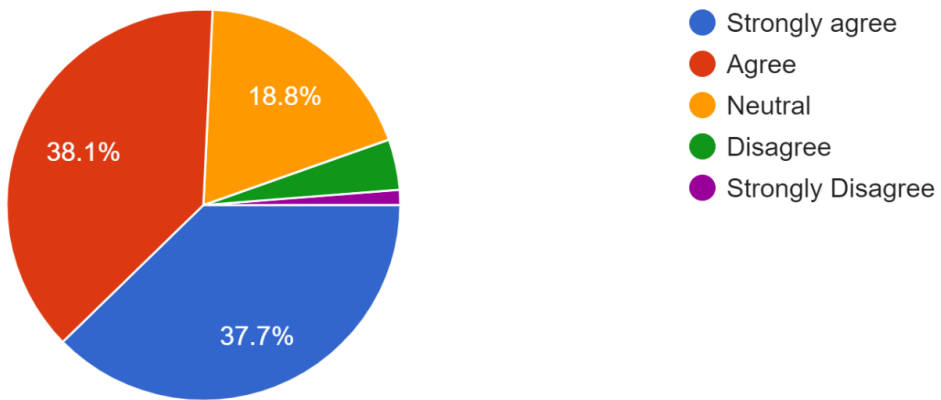
Q8: Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready.



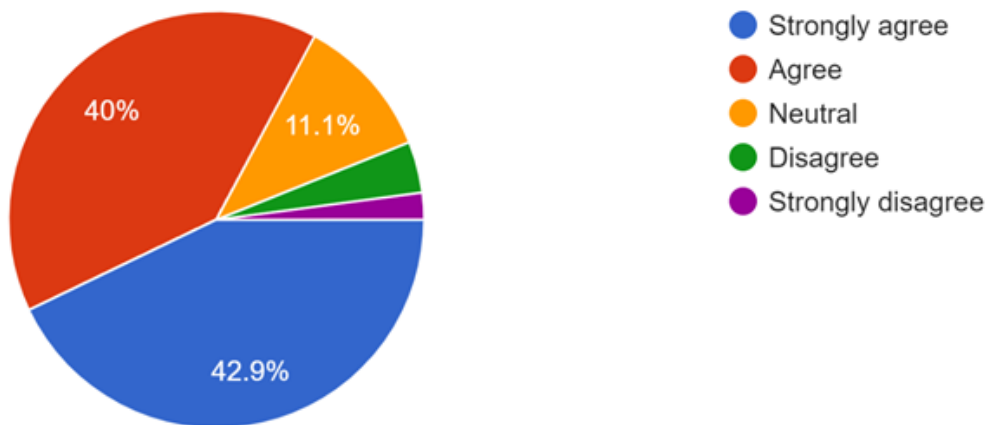
Q9: What percentage of teachers shared e-resources and learning material in 2020-21?

Suggestions:

Need more practical classes, Apart from lectures and tutorials, ppt presentations and film screenings should also be there in order to make classes more engaging and coherent
Extracurricular activities in college should improve; Separate infrastructure for societies and departments should be allocated
The amphitheatre should be rebuilt so that various functions can be conducted; Classrooms, should be made more attractive; More lights in classrooms and clean washrooms; Install ACs in classrooms, if not in all but atleast ACs should be installed in common rooms. Sports Infrastructure improvement required. Our college needs a place where students in a dance society can practice; Parking for students required. There should be sections for the courses having more than 40 students
Teachers should inform students, if on leave; Teachers are requested to cover the entire syllabus and to inspire the students to be a good person rather than a good student; to focus more on weak students; Bi-lingual lectures in need; All professors should compulsorily share e-resources and materials for the subjects they teach. Adding ability and knowledge to teachers to be able to teach and help students with mental health issues without adding to their stress triggers.
Allow students to take personal books / laptops in library. More books and journals from Cambridge University should be made available. Students should be given the access to JSTOR and other academic website. college should issue more than 3 books on a library card as there are 5-7 subjects in each semester; The time of library should be increased by an hour
Assignment marks should be fairly evaluated ;Internal Assessment Mark System Should be improved and not be partiality!
Make sure that there are enough teachers in every department so students would not suffer because of shortage of teachers; At time of recruitment of professors communication skills should be given importance.
Timings of our classes is not uniform. Some classes are in the early morning and some classes are in the late evening. The gap between our classes is not reasonable which can be improved.
Introduce finance subject into collage teach students about money which is truely more important than the other stuff
As our college has sufficient gym equipment and many of us r also interested in gym, adding a gym course as a GE would be beneficial in moral and physical development of an individual plus creating leaders in their respective fields.
Attendance shouldn't be made compulsion as it's really hard to maintain it as we are preparing for competitive exams as well.
Better Placement/internship opportunities required; more events should be organised for soft skills.
