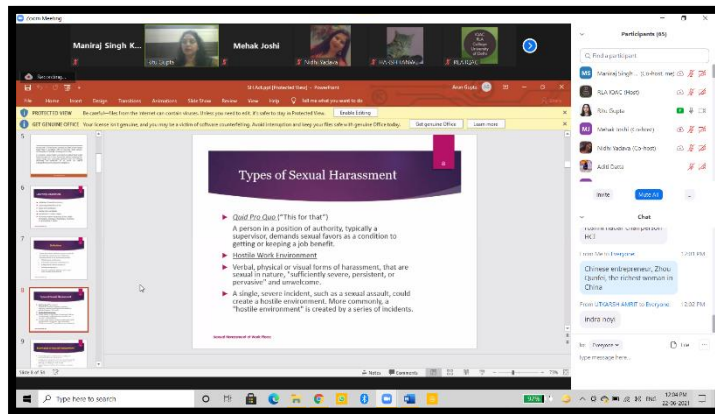

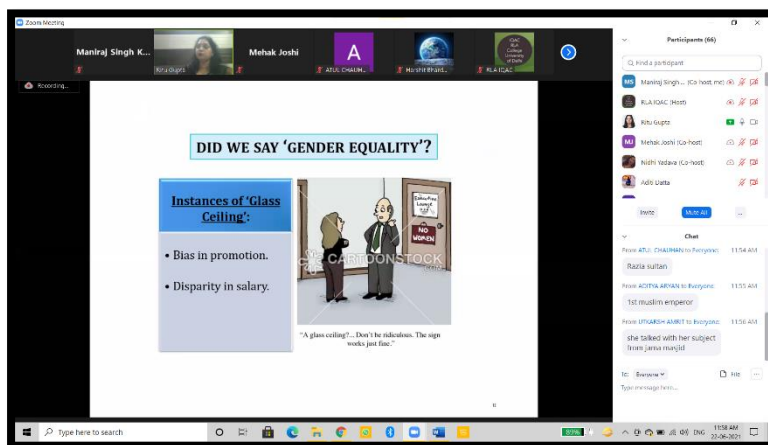

SECTION 509, IPC

Sec 509 of the IPC states that whoever intending to insult the modesty of any women, utters any word, makes any sound or gesture or exhibits any object which intrudes upon the privacy of such woman shall be punished with imprisonment upto 3 years and fine.
