Report of NSS Activities : 2016-17

1. NSS DAY CELEBRATION: SEPTEMBER 2016

NSS day was celebrated with on the theme: **Ill effects of drug addiction" (substance abuse). The following activities were conducted:**

- a. **Street play/nukkad natak** by NSS Volunteers.
- b. **Awareness rally** (50 volunteers) in the college campus on the theme **“Ill effects of drug addiction”**.
- c. **Slogan writing** competition (Hindi/English)

2. VITTIYA SAKSHARTA ABHIYAAN: December 2016-Jan 2017.

The vittiya saksharta Abhiyaan, a campaign for promoting digital economy through youth volunteers is an effort in taking forward Prime Minister Narendra Modi's initiative to turn India into a cashless society. We launched this abhiyaan with over 70 students from NCC, NSS and Students Union on 22nd Dec 2016.

This program was guided and supervised by Principal Dr R.K.Gupta, NCC officer Capt Dr Sanjay Kumar Sharma, NSS Program officer, Dr Prerna Diwan and Convener, Students Union, Dr S.C. Dabas. The following events were conducted in this regard:

- a. **Awareness workshop** about cashless means of payment conducted by team of officers from State bank of India including the Branch manager, Mrs Ritu Bhasin, Motibagh branch through powerpoint lecture and demonstration. They explained about USSD (Unstructured Supplementary Service Data), UPI (Unified Payment Interface), E-wallets, Rupay cards, internet banking, , AEPS (Aadhar Enabled Payment

Sytem). They also discussed about poS and its types. It was a great experience for the student volunteers to learn from bank team.

b. Students visited market area around motibagh to motivate vendors to use cashless means of payment.

c. Students **visited market area** after some days to notice the change in percentage of vendors using cashless means of payment.

d. **Awareness rally** for college students and staff carried on national Youth day about cashless means of payment. The volunteers went to each classroom to explain the benefits and types of cashless payment. They also explained it to all non- teaching staff.

e. Students volunteers also took responsibility to **educate ten families** in their neighbourhood about cashless means of payment.

Saathak Dhaawan was selected and he attended the youth festival held in Rohtak. It is an annual gathering of youth celebrated to commemorate the birth anniversary of the youth icon Swami Vivekananda. It is organized by Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports. The festival was attended by 10000 youth delegates from different states and union territories across the country

6. SWACH BHARAT ABHIYAAN: January 2017
