## RAM LAL ANAND COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY OF DELHI



Ram Lal Anand College was founded in the year 1964 by late Shri Ram Lal Anand, a senior advocate in the supreme court of India, in response to the growing social demand in the sixties for providing educational opportunities at the university level. The college was initially managed by

the Ram Lal Anand Trust. It was later taken over by the University of Delhi. Since 1973, it has been run by the University of Delhi as a University Maintained Institution.

The college is located in the picturesque surroundings against the backdrop of the Aravalli ranges in the neighbourhood of the south campus of the University of Delhi and several other educational institutions. It has a vast campus, spread over ten acres of land with green lawns and elegant buildings of much sprawling architectural merit. The college has excellent infrastructure, with the state-of-the-art laboratories, seminar room, amphitheatre, library, playground and cafeteria. The campus is Wi-Fi enabled. Being in a multi-disciplinary, co-educational institution it has approximately 1500 students pursuing different courses in Arts, Commerce and Science streams. Ram Lal Anand College is administered by a statutory governing body as per the university ordinances and legislated by the Executive Council of the University of Delhi.

The college boasts of a highly learned and committed teaching faculty of about 90 teachers. ## INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS: A NEW INSIGHT GALORE!

“A lot of people think international relations is like a game of chess. But it's not a game of chess, where people sit quietly, thinking out their strategy, taking their time between moves. It's more like a game of billiards, with a bunch of balls clustered together.”

-Madeleine Albright

The study of relations among nations has fascinated scholars for several centuries. However, the term international was first used by Jeremy Bentham in the latter part of the eighteenth century, although its Latin equivalent *inter gentes* were used a century earlier by Richard Zouch. Both of them had used this term in respect of that branch of law which was called law of nations, which later became 'International Law'. During the nineteenth and twentieth centuries, international relations grew rapidly. Today nation-states have become far too interdependent; and relations among them whether political or those related to trade and commerce, have developed into an essential area of knowledge. In this unit, we are mainly concerned with the political relations among sovereign societies called nations, or nation-states. After the Second World War, the interdependence of sovereign States has grown immensely. Meanwhile, in the present jet age travel has become so fast that distances have been considerably reduced; and with the revolution in the field of communication, today's satellite era has brought people so close to each other that, international relations have assumed unprecedented importance both as a 'condition' and as a 'discipline'

Political events are important, but even economic developments, trade, commerce and activities of actors like multinational corporations are no less significant. With intense interaction between the government, institutions and socio-political level actors ultimately the Indian foreign policy is made. The outcome of the policy process, “foreign policy” is the concrete policy directed towards a foreign nation or external policy issue.

## INDIA'S FOREIGN POLICY

In its seventh decade since independence, India today stands at a crossroads in its relations with the rest of the world. Being one of the most powerful economies in the world today gives India clout on the global stage matched only by a few other states. Coupled with highly professional armed forces well-ensconced in a liberal democratic polity, India is emerging as an entity that can decisively shift the global balance of power. But the world is not waiting for India to put its own house in order and to come to terms with its rising profile. Already, demands are being made on India by the international community, expecting it to play a global role inconsonance with its rising stature. India is now being invited to the G-8 summits, is being called on to shoulder global responsibilities from nuclear proliferation to global warming to Iraq, and is being viewed as much more than a mere "South Asian" power.

As India's profile and stature has risen in the international system, the fissures in foreign and security policy issues are out in the open. India is debating the choices it faces on foreign policy like it has never done before. Indian foreign and security policy is currently grappling with a range of issues that are controversial but central to the future of Indian global strategy. These include, but are not limited to, India's relations with the United States; the idea of a strategic triangle involving Russia, China, and India; India's nuclear doctrine and its impact on the emerging civil-military relations; India's position on the ballistic missile defence system; India's relations with Iran and Israel; and India's quest for energy security. On almost all these issues, there is an intense debate in the Indian polity and the strategic community, and how this debate resolves itself will, in many ways, determine the direction of Indian foreign policy for years to come.

## DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE

The Department of Political Science at Ram Lal Anand College is engaging its students in getting first-hand experience through debates, dialogues, symposiums, national level seminars and through research. The teaching and research programme of the Department is based on a comprehensive social science approach that integrates and interrogates sociological, political, economic, philosophical and cultural dimensions. It encourages a comprehensive study and research in the field of governance and recent political debates, keeping especially the Indian and the international developments in focus.

The Department of Political Science has been attempting to decentre the notions and practices of the political from its conventional moorings in Eurocentric thought and history. While engaged in moving away in its research agenda from dominantly comparative models for some time, the Department has also insisted on learning and undertaking research on the current debates and institutions.

Our general focus has been supplemented by a growing emphasis on the need to combine theory with ethnographic and archival work. We believe that it is necessary to acquaint ourselves with both International Relations and Foreign Policy in order to address and open out new empirical material to fresh questions. We are convinced that this will illuminate the unfolding reality of India and other countries/regions and also open out new research agendas for other institutions outside in and India. ## PROFESSOR HARSH V. PANT



Professor Harsh V Pant is Director, Studies and Head of the Strategic Studies Programme at Observer Research Foundation, New Delhi. He holds a joint appointment with the Department of Defence Studies and King's India Institute as Professor of International Relations at King's College London. He is also a Non-Resident Fellow with the Wadhvani Chair in US-India Policy Studies at the Center for Strategic and International Studies, Washington, DC. Professor Pant has been a Visiting Professor at the Indian Institute of Management, Bangalore; a Visiting Fellow at the Center for the Advanced Study of India, University of Pennsylvania; a Visiting Scholar at the Center for International Peace and Security Studies, McGill

University; and an Emerging Leaders Fellow at the Australia-India Institute, University of Melbourne. Professor Pant's current research is focused on Asian security issues. His most recent books include *New Directions in India's Foreign Policy: Theory and Praxis* (Cambridge University Press), *India's Nuclear Policy* (Oxford University Press), *The US Pivot and Indian Foreign Policy* (Palgrave Macmillan), *Handbook of Indian Defence Policy* (Routledge), *India's Afghan Muddle* (HarperCollins), and *The US-India Nuclear Pact: Policy, Process and Great Power Politics* (Oxford University Press). Professor Pant writes regularly for various Indian and international media outlets including the Japan Times, the Wall Street Journal, the National (UAE), the Hindustan Times, and the Telegraph.
