*Dastoor*, the Indian Music Society of the College was formed in 2015. From its very inception, the society has been very active, performing regularly in intra as well as intercollege competitions. The society held its annual auditions on 8<sup>th</sup> August, 2019 in the College amphitheatre. The office bearer of the society is: Shreeya Dikshit (President), and Ayushi Singh (Vice President). For their guidance, the College appointed Mr. Anirudh Varma, founder of the Anirudh Varma Collective. It is a collaborative project, bringing artists & musicians together as music teachers.

In the Fresher's Welcome party held on 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2019, the society members performed the *Saraswati Vandana* in Raag *Baageshri* lined with instrumental and mashups. *Dastoor* also participated in the 1<sup>st</sup> inter college event held at Oasis, BITS, Pilani from 19<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> October2019.
