POLITICAL THOUGHT

Thought is more than a field within Political Science. It is an important sense and also works as the foundation of the subject. Whenever Politics or Political Science is defined, there is a need to understand both normative and empirical problems. Political Thought deals with the normative aspect of Political Science. In this regard, it demonstrates the limits to Political Science and allows us to understand what we know and what we do not. Political Thought teaches us what questions to ask in Political Science.

OBJECTIVES OF THE COURSE

Educate Students

It educates students about normative political values, concepts and debates centred on these along with political processes, theories, and governments.

Analytical and Research Skills

This course will offer students the analytical and research skills needed to understand, explain, describe & evaluate society, politics, governments, and organized associational life.

Study of Political Philosophies

This course involves the study of traditional, comparative and major political philosophies. It covers a very broad field which incorporates the study of normative concepts and historical and modern political systems.



DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE

The Department of Political Science at Ram Lal Anand College, University of Delhi engages its students in first-hand experience through debates, dialogues, symposiums, national level seminars, and research. The Department's teaching and research programme is founded on a broad social science approach that integrates and interrogates sociological, political, economic, philosophical, and cultural dimensions. It promotes comprehensive study and research in the field of governance and recent political debates, with a particular emphasis on Indian and international developments.

The Department has been attempting to decentre political concepts and practises from their traditional moorings in Eurocentric thought and history. While the Department has been working to shift its research agenda away from dominantly comparative models for some time, it has also insisted on learning about and conducting research on current debates and institutions. Our broad focus has been augmented by a growing emphasis on the importance of integrating theory with ethnographic and archival work.

This certificate course is interdisciplinary and is designed for the students keeping in mind their need, aspirations, aims and career and is also designed for enhancing their skills.
