

Annual Report (NSS) 2021-22

The National Service Scheme (NSS) was launched in the year 1969, also Mahatma Gandhi's birth centenary, in 37 universities with the primary goal to let community services become a source of personality development of student volunteers. As of today, the scheme runs in all Indian states and universities under the guidance of the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports. Its motto, *'Not Me But You'* helps students prioritize their community above themselves, and assists them in including it in the problem-solving process.

The NSS unit of Ram Lal Anand College has been extensively working to promote a holistic development environment for its student volunteers in preparation of their future, with an emphasis on community services.

The session of 2022-23 has been fruitful under the guidance of the NSS Program Officer, Dr. Rita Jain, who led the team to explore innovative ways to give back to the community. She was assisted by the following Office Bearers and Group Leaders, who had been selected for their positions based on a vivid history of selflessness, experience, and a strong work ethic:

Adya Venkateswara Minaxi, Anshuman Kumar Singh, Arnav Kumar, Deepak Rawat, Dhruv Bhadouria, Harsh Raj, Ishita Goel, Raunak Singh, Sonu Choudhary, Tamjeed Athar, Tisnoor Singh Chaddha, and Yashwini Chandra were nominated as Executive Members and Team Heads of the unit, and have been listed alphabetically.

The counsel of college Principal Dr. Rakesh Kumar Gupta and Program Officer Dr. Rita Jain has been the most effective in maintaining the standards of deliverance of NSS RLAC.

The month of August started off with enthusiastic activities in light of upcoming Independence Day. These included the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign where the NSS Unit of our college conducted various activities from 1 August 2022 onwards. These activities were wide-ranging, and included three projects of flag pasting, dissemination and article writing, and nearly 30 (17) volunteers actively participated. This was followed by college decoration by 15 (10) volunteers on 6 August 2022, participation in a rally held at North Campus by University of Delhi where 20 (9) of our volunteers showed up on 10 August 2022, Flag Making on 12 August 2022 where 50 (27) volunteers sent in their innovative attempts at best out of waste. The addition of Tiranga Yatra on 12 August 2022 where 70 (45) volunteers participated finally culminated in the celebration of Independence Day on 15 August 2022 in the attendance of 70 (34) volunteers. 17 August paved the way for an intra-college Declamation titled 'Chand Alfaaz – Desh ke Naam' with a participation of 37 (18) volunteers. The month came to a flourishing end with the celebration of World Water Week, where 83 (39) volunteers sent in their creative digital entries.

The month of September of 2022 was fruitful in terms of service as the month was started through a 5-day swachhata pakhwada was organized by the NSS unit lasting from 11th-15th September, which included activities like poster making, cleanliness drive, debate, etc., over 120 (58) volunteers gave their part. This spirit of service was continued in the 2-day event of nasha mukt bharat abhiyaan on 18th and 19th September which included an intra unit presentation competition and a nukkad natak respectively, and 95

(55) volunteers participated enthusiastically. To mark the 100-year completion of DU and 150th birth anniversary of Shri Aurobindo the NSS unit facilitated a mobile book exhibition organized by NBT India on 22nd September gathering over 130 (68) of our volunteers. On 24th September the final activity of the month was done through the celebration of 53rd NSS day on Google Meet, first by a virtual address by the principal of RLAC Dr. Rakesh Kumar Gupta and by a webinar on Thalassemia by Dr. Pravas Mishra, there was a participation of approximately 115 (72) volunteers.

The month of October was kicked off by the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti. An Inter-College Creative Writing Competition, with the theme 'Gandhi: The Beacon of Hope - A Tribute to Babu, his Ideologies and Philosophy', was organized. The event saw a participation of 22 (10) volunteers. The next event was on 4th of October, Animal Welfare Day. Feeding stray animals and birds was what the volunteers were required to do and a total of 32 (18) volunteers participated. Followed by these was the Mentimeter Quiz Competition about Indian Air Force, held on 8th October, with over 90 (71) volunteers participating. Under Fit India Freedom Run 3.0, 25 (13), 33 (15) and 30 (11) volunteers participated in 3 events, spread across 3 days of the event. Our Self Defence Workshop, in collaboration with WWAC, saw a participation of 30 (30) female students who received 5 days of self-defence training. On World Mental Health Day, over 80 volunteers (40) made posters, etc. that were to be put on their social media handles so as to spread a word towards mental health. Under the event Swachhata 2.0, an overwhelming number of 61 (25) volunteers cleaned the allocated areas and 45 (21) volunteers marched towards the cause of cleaner surroundings. 77 (34) volunteers prepared slogans (both digital and handmade) for this cleanliness drive.

In the later half of the month, a seminar was organized on HPV Awareness. This was attended by students from all courses, whether a part of NSS RLAC or not, however the event did garner the attendance of 40 (25) volunteers. A four-day long Daan Utsav (material donation drive) was also organized with over 110 (49) people donating for the drive. Under the Mega Swachhata Drive, over 70 (29) volunteers collected and segregated more than 25 kgs of garbage from the allocated areas near the college campus. On National Ayurveda Day, a total of 85 (46) volunteers prepared posters on medicinal plants which are of Ayurvedic importance and have positive health benefits. On 28th October, Pledge Taking and Documentary Screening were held as a part of the birth anniversary celebration of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. Almost 80 (34) volunteers took part in the screening and pledge taking. The concluding events of the month were Essay Writing and Handmade Poster Making on the theme of 'Ek Bharat, Shreshth Bharat'. These events jointly saw a participation of 65 (30) volunteers.

The month of November started off with a new hope for corruption-free India by creating awareness among youth. NSS RLAC also received 70 (32) entries as they hosted an E-poster making competition based on the theme "Corruption-free India for a developed nation" on November 4, 2022 within Vigilance Awareness week. Followed by another poster making competition held offline in seminar hall on the occasion of National Cancer Awareness Day celebrated on 7th November 2022 to ensure the theme "close the care gap". In total, 52 (26) entries were recorded among 90 registrations. On November 12, an online webinar was organised to mark the significance of POSCO act, in collaboration with Sakshi NGO under the theme "POSCO ACT - Sexual Abuse towards Children: how can we protect them" attended by more than 110 (52) students. In addition to the community service, The NSS unit held its Orientation Program 2022-'23 on November 13, 2022, on an online platform to persuade the newcomers to join the path of service and make the 125 (68) attendees adhere to "NOT ME BUT YOU" motto.

Nearly halfway through the month, approximately 22 (10) volunteers participated in the campaign 'Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyan' against drug abuse, and performed a nukkad natak on the occasion of Children's day on 14th November 22. Meanwhile 70 (32) volunteers distributed a stationary kit at JJ colony, South Moti Bagh. Subsequently an Education Camp was organized from November 15 to December 8, to uplift the

future of deprived children through wisdom and hope. More than 100 (65) volunteers came forward to contribute their parts. To honor the founding day of the Press Council of India on National Press Day on 16 November 2022, an inter-college declamation/speech competition on the subject of " Journalism under digital siege" was organised, which saw the participation of 17 (6) volunteers. 75 (32) beautifully articulated slogan entries were shared and posted by our volunteers on 19th November 22 with an opinion of "tackling the Global Sanitation Crisis". To ensure the animals around us are protected and cared upon, we organized a voluntary event 'Feeding stray dogs and Animals' on 26th November 2022. Volunteers were asked to send geotagged photos of feeding at least three stray animals and birds among whom 45 (27) made a difference. On 26th November, a formal Preamble recitation ceremony was held as a pledge taking ceremony on the occasion of Constitution Day, 57 (39) volunteers came forward to take their pledge. Following that, an official Orientation ceremony was virtually held for the newly joining volunteers, and the attendance reached a high of 180 (88).

The unit entered the month of December with a quiz on World AIDS Day. Each volunteer had to get at least 5 people to fill the awareness quiz forms and thus we received over 250 (120) responses. This was followed by a sapling plantation event on the National Pollution Control Day in which 130+ (64) volunteers planted. On the Indian Navy Day, 185 (84) volunteers paid gratitude to the navy personnel through handwritten/digital notes of thanks. Under Swachhata 3.0, over 150 (75) volunteers safely collected and disposed of garbage of all kinds from the nearby areas. On the National Energy Conservation Day, the unit held a digital slogan writing event in which 190+ (90) volunteers participated. To commemorate Vijay Diwas, a handmade poster making event was organized. The event saw a participation of 55 (23) student volunteers. Kisan Diwas, too, was marked by another online quiz consisting of 15 questions. A total of 51 (32) volunteers submitted their responses. To mark the end of the year 2022, the unit organized a donation drive, The Joy of Giving, on Christmas. 130 (54) volunteers went to various places and donated freshly cooked food and warm clothes to the ones in need, thus truly ending the year with the core spirit and motto of National Service Scheme.

The spirit of the volunteers was not reduced in the month of January 2023 as 110 (42) entries were received in an E – poster making competition for Global family day on 1st January, starting off the year with the volunteers reflecting the true essence of NSS. To strengthen their service the volunteers on 3rd January organized cup distribution drive for the underprivileged children with 22 (12) volunteers. On 4th January a message/quote using beads in Braille language was encouraged on world Braille Day where 42 (21) volunteers participated. The World Day of War Orphans on 6th January was commemorated by 200 (98) volunteers who wrote an article on their issues. A blood donation camp was set up on college premises in collaboration with Indian red cross which received 70 (23) blood donations on 9th January. 2 (1) volunteers were selected for the Raktveer Conference conducted by the NSS Unit of Rajdhani College attending a conference on 11th January. The National Youth Day was celebrated through 48 (17) volunteers giving an inspiring video message.

In the next half of the month, a letter writing event was conducted on 15th January for Indian army day where 130 (54) volunteers expressed their gratitude. Under Mission LiFE a Sapling plantation drive was organized on 17th January with 202 (87) volunteer participation, under the same mission on 18th January a Mentimeter quiz competition was held with 170 (85) volunteers. On Parakram Divas a brief talk on Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose in the college premises was held on 23rd January with 45 (18) volunteers. On the occasion of National Girl child day on 24th January a Sanitary Napkin Distribution Drive was conducted in JJ Colony with over 100 sanitary napkin collection and 72 (32) volunteers' participation. On 25th January the NSS unit celebrated National Voters' Day through the recitation of a pledge and digital poster making competition where 200 (97) volunteers participated in all, and the Republic Day through

flag hoisting with a NCC parade, more than 190 (77) volunteers were invested. The activities in the month of January came to an end with an orientation program for the new recruited volunteers on 30th January with our programme officer Dr. Rita Jain and the chief guest Ms. Divya Shah, 123 (67) volunteers gave their participation.

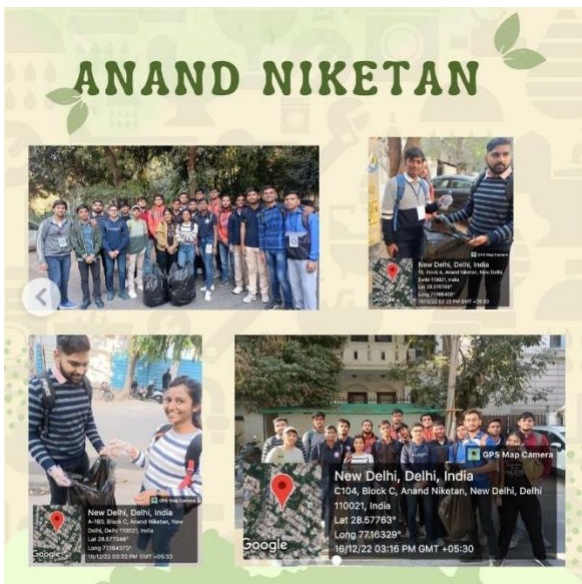
The whole orientation of February was more inclined towards environment and healthcare to aware people about the prevalent hazards. Under Anti-Tobacco Campaign - 'Uniting Our Voices and Taking Actions' and on the occasion of national cancer awareness day, an offline anti-tobacco awareness drive was conducted on 3 February 2023 in college campus and nearby locations in which over 139 (71) volunteers participated. To enhance the latent skills, an online poster making competition in correlation with Plastic Awareness Drive on 5th February '23 was conducted with the intention to reduce single-use plastics where the participation crossed 200 (119). In addition, the unit also organized an offline awareness campaign from 6th to 10th February 23 with participation ratio as 200 (93). In accordance with such environment-oriented activities, NSS unit dived into MISSION LIFE held as part of Mission Lifestyle for Environment, or Mission 'LiFE', aimed at giving back to the environment so a tree plantation drive to compensate with all the deforestation resumed by mankind. 202 (87) volunteers actively stepped in. To combat the effects of climate change and be in sync with the mission, an online handmade poster making activity on 19th February 2023 in which 150 (80) volunteers took part. A Waste Segregation Awareness & Cleanliness Drive was also regulated from 20 to 22 February 2023 in localities like JJ Colony, Basant Gaon, Satya Niketan, and South Campus and 200 (105) volunteers showed up to mark a truly inspiring, active end to the short month.

The activities in the month of March of 2023 were also of significance as it was started on the note of feeding stray animals on 2nd March, with 150 (75) volunteers taking part. To commemorate the International Women's Day the unit launched a digital dissemination, a poster making event where 175 (100) volunteers participated. "SANKALP'23 – celebrating the hands that serve" turned out to be the benchmark of the year as the NSS unit successfully orchestrated the annual cultural festival on 20th and 21st March, with the conduction of various fun and exciting activities there was a footfall of over 1000 and the participation of volunteers from 15 colleges. Nearly every volunteer, amounting to 242 (103) gave their time, dedication, and hard work to this large-scale event. From 20 to 30 March 2023, NSS RLAC also organised "Umang : material donation drive" in collaboration with Goonj, under the banner of SANKALP. Items such as clothes, stationaries, bags, etc., were donated by as many as 50 (35) volunteers and were further distributed to people in need. The month came to a flourishingly green end with 75 (50) volunteers participating in the Tree Plantation Drive on 26 March 2023.

The month of April was all about awareness and dissemination. Starting off the month on 2 April 2023 was World Autism Acceptance Day, wherein 120 (65) volunteers shared creative posters on the theme 'Light it Up Blue'. What followed was an Awareness Session on HIV & AIDS on 3 April 2023, with 75 (40) volunteers listening with rapt attention to the speaker of the day, Ms. Sujita Gahlaut. 150 (76) volunteers stepped up to take the lead for another Education Camp on 3 April 2023, which lasted for over a month. The relatively calmer month came to a very relevant, realistic finale with a Health Talk on Stress Management by Ms. Samridhi Pahaiwan, a senior consultant psychologist with Amaha, on 19 April 2023. It was attended by 82 (44) volunteers.

May and June were two months that went by in a flash, owing to the exam season. Not letting their exams deter them from what they believe in, 135 (66) volunteers participated in a poster-making event held on 19 May 2023 in light of National Endangered Species Day. 15 (7) volunteers got in touch with their inner peace in 10-day yoga camp held at the college, from 12 June onwards. The month of June came to a

successful, almost healing close with 87 (33) volunteers enjoying the craft of Yoga with their family on 21 June 2023, in light of the International Yoga Day.
