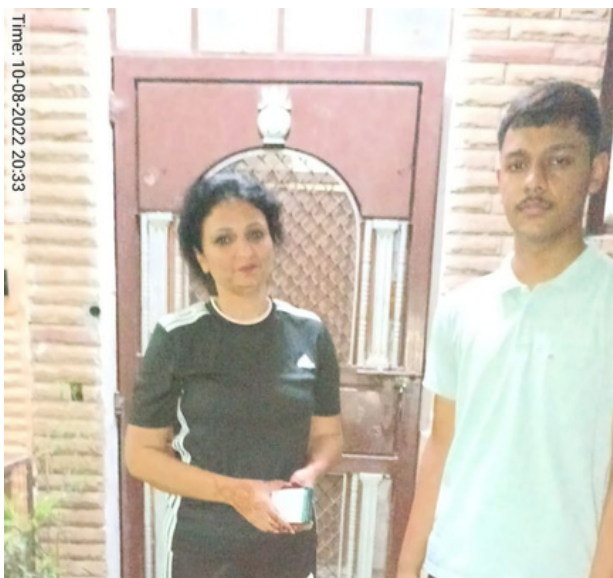
OVERVIEW



PROJECT 3: UNSUNG HERO OF INDIA'S FREEDOM STRUGGLE

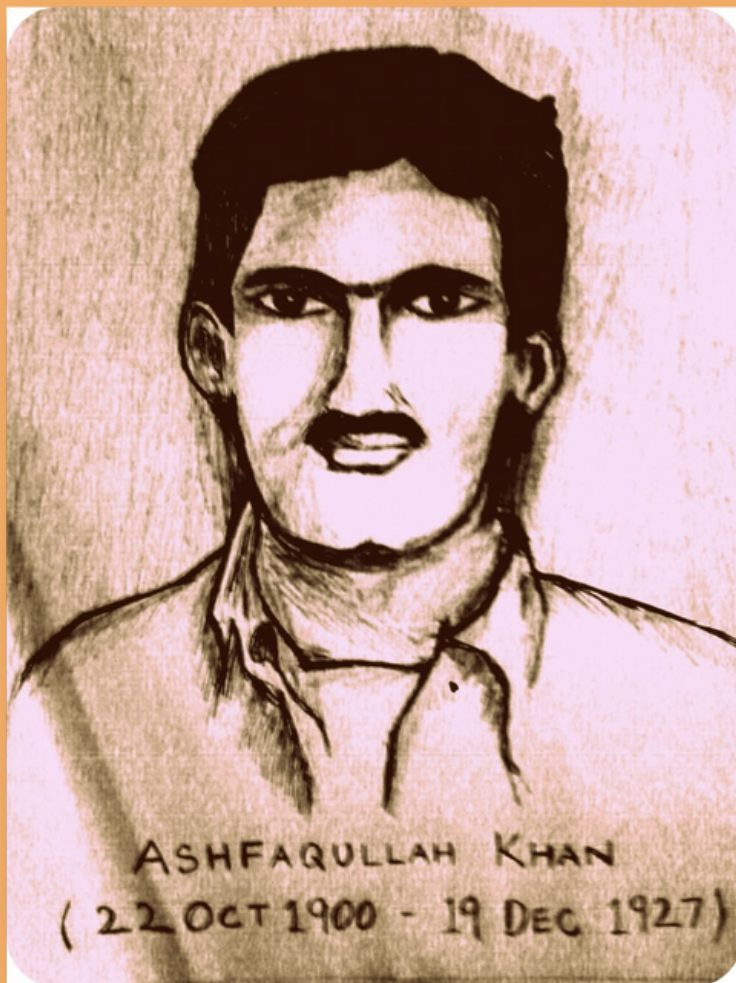

During his stint as a British Soldier , he completed his course as an 'Intelligence Officer & Army Draftsman'. Later on, with a positive nod from Rash Behari Bose (Chief of the Azad Hind Fauj) he joined the Azad Hind Fauj. He was posted as a 'Civilian Surveyor' in the Intelligence Bureau.
