Overview

National Service Scheme Unit of Ram Lal Anand College celebrated its first ever annual festival "SANKALP'21" with the theme

Volunteerism: An Inspiration in Action on 11 and 12 April 2021 under the guidance of Principal Dr. Rakesh Kumar Gupta and Program Officer Dr. Rita Jain. The festival was held in online mode through the Google meet. The Inauguration Ceremony for the festival was held at 10:30 AM on 11th April where Dr. Rita Jain inaugurated SANKALP'21 accompanied by her words of wisdom for the organizing team. A glimpse of the exciting 2 days ahead was given via a timeline of events to be conducted in the festival. Ground work done by the NSS RLAC Unit before and during the pandemic was presented through a PowerPoint presentation. The two-day extravaganza consisted of three events which saw 72 female participants out of total 200+ from over 10 universities from across India.

Sanrachna - The Story Telling Competition

An event dominated by female storytellers saw 15 female participants out of the total 30 from over 10 universities who participated in the event. The competition allowed the students to showcase their narration and writing abilities. The first round of the competition was conducted on 11th April at 11:30 AM, and the second round was held on 12th April at 10:30 AM. In Round 1, the participants submitted their work in written format and top 10 participants got an opportunity to narrate their stories in Round 2. The entries in Round 2 were judged by a panel of judges consisting of Dr. Rita Jain (PO NSS) and Dr. Deepshikha. The top three winners of the competition were endowed with the cash prizes of Rs. 1500, Rs. 1000, and Rs. 500 respectively.





Treasureopedia - The Quiz Competition


The Quiz Competition was based on Social and Historical figures of prominence of India i.e. those who have contributed in the making of society and nation. More than 100 teams registered for the event from various institutes like IIT, NIT, Manipal University and BHU other than DU out of which 60 teams played Round 1. Round 2 was organized on 'kahoot.it'. The Quiz allowed everyone to showcase their skills and knowledge. The first round of the competition was conducted on 11th April at 3:00 PM, followed by the second round on 12th April at 12:00 PM. The top two teams (of two members each), i.e. the first and second position holders were awarded with the cash prizes of Rs. 1500 and Rs. 1000 respectively.





Talk Session by Ms. Anupama Datta

Ms. Datta is the Editor of HelpAge India Research and Development Journal. She has been working with HelpAge India, a leading charity working for disadvantaged elderly, for the past 20 years.
