

# INTERNATIONAL MOTHER LANGUAGE DAY


- On International Mother Language Day, **NSS RLAC** organized a **Poem Recitation Activity** on **21.02.2021**.




# TALK ON CLIMATE CHANGE AND EXTREMES




### **WORLD NGO DAY**








### **NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY**


- On 28 February 2021 NATIONAL SCIENCE DAY, NSS RLAC organized a Crossword Puzzle.
