Besides, the unit organized Plastic Awareness Drives in following locations-

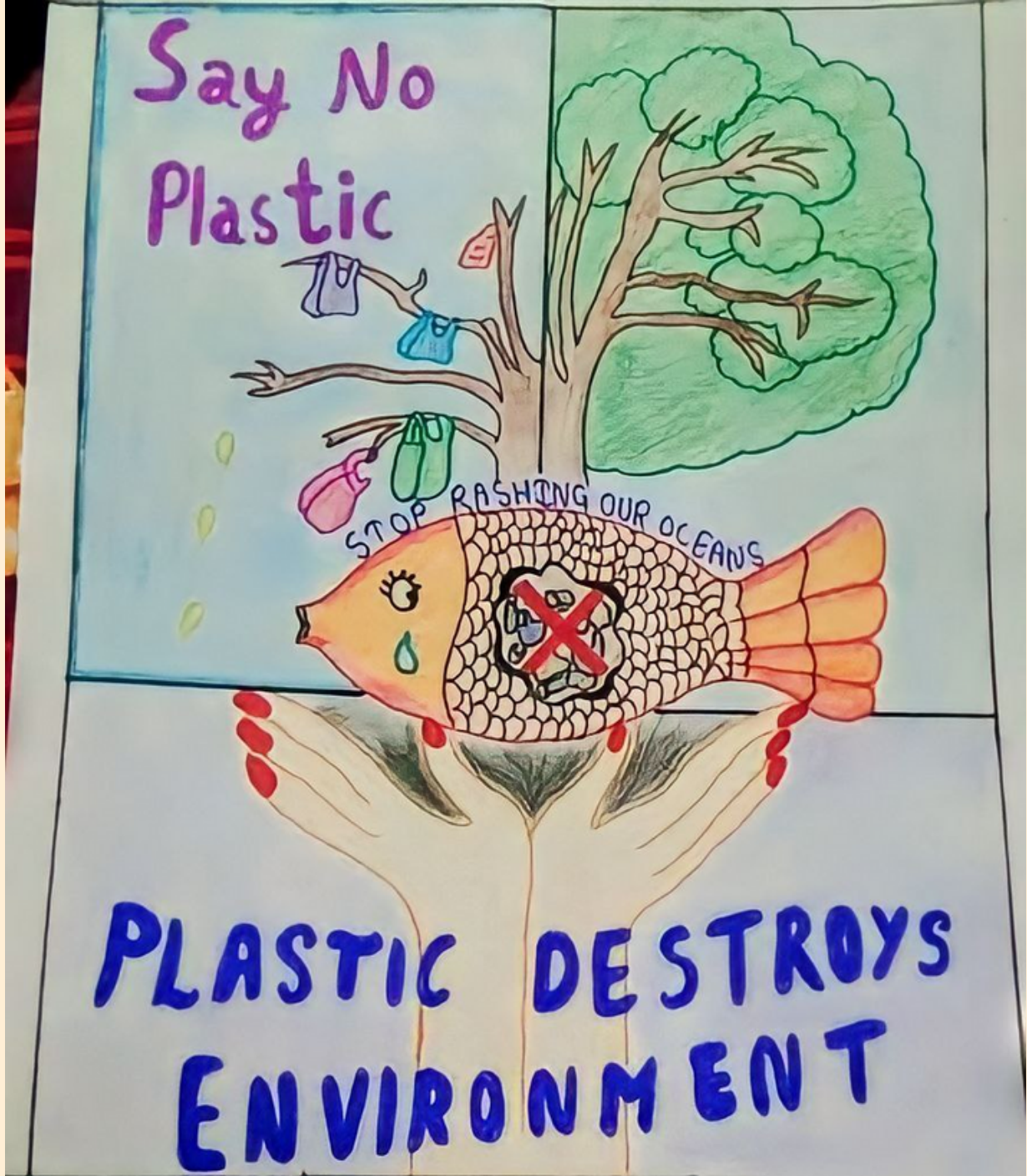
- Ram Lal Anand College and nearby areas

12 volunteers from NSS RLAC put a feather in our cap with their remarkable participation!

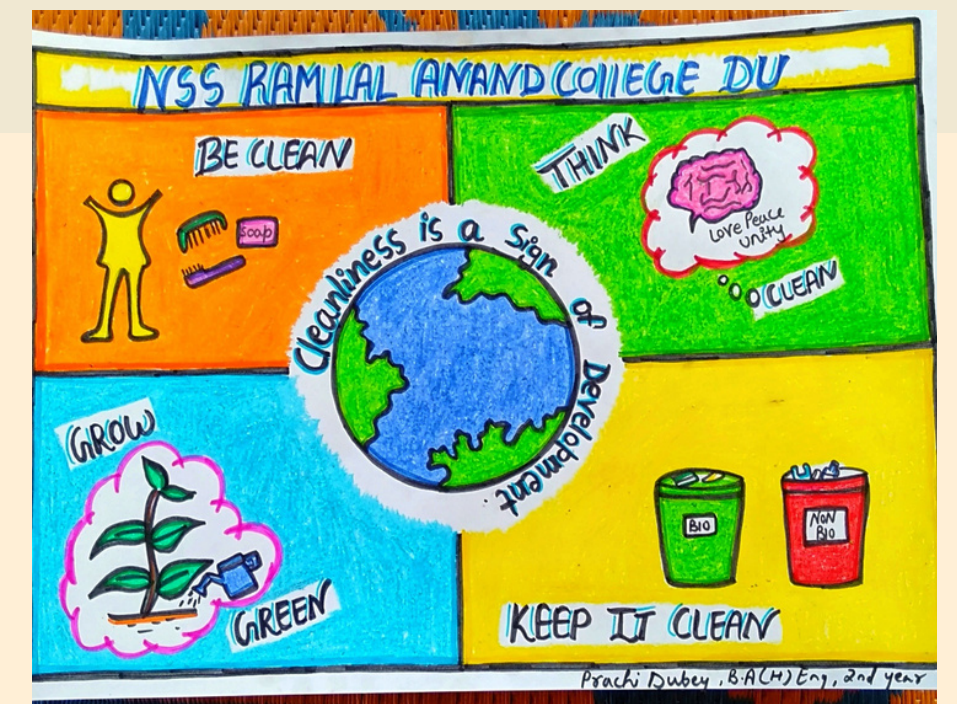


WASTE SEGREGATION AWARENESS & CLEANLINESS DRIVE

19TH-22ND FEBRUARY

Waste Segregation refers to dividing waste into dry and wet and disposing it appropriately. This is simple to understand but yet not followed widely. With the vision of spreading awareness about waste segregation and contributing to Mission LiFE, NSS Ram Lal Anand College organised a Waste Segregation Awareness and Cleanliness Drive from 19th to 22nd of February, 2023.

The event was conducted in two parts, the first was a Poster Making Activity where volunteers had to make handmade posters on the theme of waste segregation. The volunteers participated enthusiastically in the activity and we received a huge number of entries. These posters were later used in the second part of event which was Door to door awareness drive.



From 20th till 22nd February, 2023, the Unit organised an awareness drive on the above mentioned theme in locations like JJ Colony, Basant Gaon, Satya Niketan and South Campus. In this drive, the volunteers were divided into groups and allotted a locality where they had to conduct the drive. We covered three different localities in three different days.
