Summary

Suggestions regarding the ERP system introduced for Attendance,

IA, extracurricular societies information and placement (app)

Positive Feedback:

- 1. The app is considered a good initiative, aiding both students and teachers in maintaining discipline and punctuality.
- 2. Useful for tracking attendance records and academic information in a fair and transparent manner.
- 3. Helps students stay informed about their attendance and internal assessments.
- 4. Conceptually, the ERP system is a progressive step towards integrating attendance and academic tracking.
- 5. Features like notifications, marks display, and event tracking are appreciated.

Areas for Improvement:

1. Time Table Issues:

- o Students traveling long distances face issues with large gaps between classes.
- o Classes should not have gaps longer than 1 hour to avoid wasting time.

2. Attendance Criteria and Exemptions:

o Attendance exemptions should be considered for students preparing for competitive exams or living far from the college.

3. Placement and Internship Opportunities:

- o Limited opportunities for students in specific fields like microbiology.
- o Placement and internship notifications should be more frequent and accessible.

4. Extracurricular Activities and Societies:

- o Extracurricular attendance should be granted only for actual participation days, not randomly.
- o Society attendance is often not properly recorded or updated on the ERP.
- o The system should track and display society participation more transparently and timely.

5. Technical and Functional Issues:

- o The app frequently experiences glitches and bugs.
- o The ERP portal and app often show discrepancies in attendance and marks.
- o The user interface needs to be more user-friendly and easier to navigate.
- o Notifications are often delayed or not received, causing students to miss important updates.
- o Attendance should be marked and updated on the same day to avoid errors.

6. Policy and Management Concerns:

- o The system is perceived as restrictive, limiting students' ability to manage their time and explore other interests.
- o The ERP system has created stress among students due to its rigid attendance policies.
- o Some faculty members and administrative staff are unresponsive or rude about ERP-related issues.
- o The process for addressing discrepancies in attendance and marks is cumbersome and slow.

7. General Improvements:

o The overall attendance percentage should be easily accessible on the app.

- o Features from the ERP website should be integrated into the app.
- o Regular maintenance and updates should be conducted to ensure smooth operation.
- o More features like assignment tracking, performance analytics, and job listings should be added.
- o The marking scheme for internal assessments should be transparent and accurately reflected on the portal.
- o There should be a mechanism for submitting medical certificates and other documents through the app.
- o The system should include notifications for administrative updates and academic schedules.

Overall Summary: While the ERP system is a step forward in integrating academic management, there are significant areas that require improvement, particularly in addressing technical glitches, improving user experience, and ensuring accurate and timely updates. Feedback suggests a need for more flexibility in attendance policies and better support for extracurricular activities and placements.
