team holds two projects currently, one is the Paper pencils project -Roopantaran which was initiated in November 2018 which is a sustainable model to manufacture and market pencils made out of Newspapers. This project is in collaboration with Family of disabled (FOD- a non-governmental organization for the upliftment of specially abled people).
