We marked the beginning of this year by organizing an hour long Orientation to send the message associated with Enactus through to the new students enrolling in the college. Following the orientation, we went through with our recruitment drive and formed a team of 42 enthusiastic members.

The team holds two projects currently, one is the Paper Pencils project- Roopanataran which is a sustainable model to manufacture and market pencils made out of newspapers in collaboration with Family Of Disabled. Second project is still in the early stages of development – Project Bantawala, another sustainable entrepreneurship model based on upcycling glass bottles.

For Daan Utsav 2019, Enactus RLAC volunteered to boost the sales for FOD at the Janakpuri Petrol Pump. The students went in two shifts for five days and managed to get Family of Disabled heavy sales and donations as well.

The team represented both projects through participation in cross college Business Plan Competitions held at Dyal Singh College as well as bagged second position in Motilal Nehru College and setting up stalls in Hindu College for their Diwali Mela, Aryabhata College Sports Festival and ARSD College Enactus Fest.
