





ABHIVYAKTI : THE ENGLISH CREATIVE WRITING SOCIETY




In the month of February the society conducted two events simultaneously. Both of which were organized as part of '**Azadi Ka Amrut Mahotsav**'. The first event conducted was an Intra-College event under the theme '**What Independence Means To You**'. The aim of the event was to invoke patriotism and the mind to question if Independence only meant what we've been studying about in our history books. Submissions were taken via mail and each of the 70 entries was an honor to read. Ayush was awarded the 1st position for his beautiful piece, Sohagini Roy bagged the 2nd position & Sanjana the 3rd position. The winners were awarded certificates of excellence for their inspiring work.

The second event was an Intra-Society Event. The theme for this event was '**Sacrifice of our Heroes**'. This event was an attempt to keep the new society members engaged during the tiresome online mode of learning alongside testing their ability to articulate thoughts into a beautiful yet soulful spiral of words. All the entries were worth the read.

All the society members except for the council participated in the event and Jaya Pandey, Anaaya & Shelja were awarded the 1st, 2nd & 3rd positions respectively.



In the month of April the society conducted a two day Inter-University Competition '**ENCIENDELO**' on 9th & 10th April. It was a fan fiction writing competition but with a twist. It was conducted in 2 rounds. **Round 1, Historia** wherein each participant had to build up a story by using characters from different universes & genres belonging to different movies, stories or books. Out of 80 entries, only 10 entries proceeded to **Round 2, Revelio** which was the actual store of surprise. Here the participants' pieces were exchanged and they had to continue the other person's story with the theme they were given in Round 1. Out of the top 10, Anvesha from Keshav Mahaviyalaya bagged the 1st position, Rishita from Sri Venkateshwara College 2nd & Roshani from Swami Shraddhanand College 3rd.



The last event for the session was a **Slum Event** conducted on 16th April. In this event the society members and volunteers from college went to the slum and conducted a Drawing Competition for the children of the slum. More than 150 children participated in this. Beautiful art works were presented by young talents and for that they were given exciting prizes & refreshments.
