

Alumni Committee Report 2020-21

The Alumni committee of Ram Lal Anand College found itself wanting in several ways in the year 2020-21, considering the pandemic raged and suffocated people all over the world. However, the biggest achievement of the Alumni Committee in this year was to compile and prepare a database of the registered Alumni of the college and take an online feedback.

Alumni Feedback:

The Alumni Committee of Ram Lal Anand College solicited Feedback from its alumni about the college. More than 90% alumni found the college environment to be better than 'good'. Most of the students found college infrastructure growing and in good condition. All the students except a few commented that the faculty and the non teaching staff of the college was good, very good and excellent. More than 75% students commented that Training and Placement in College was above the level of 'Good'. Almost all students found the college library and canteen; the two places of they regularly visit, to be above the level of 'good'. Similar feedback was given for the programme and the significance of they degree they undertook in college. Overall, almost all students rated the college above good. About 84% students express a feel of pride towards college. Students are eagerly waiting for the time to improve and return to college for an Alumni Meet, only one third of the feedback givers have been able to attend an Alumni Meet so far. More than 86% students wanted to contribute to the college in future, and more than 77% were willing to speak to the future batches in a series of lectures. About 60% students have expressed an ability to assist college in placement activities.

Most departments held online Alumni interactions. For instance, the English department conducted two online lectures in 2020-21; one by Mr. Lalit Kashyap as the guest speaker on the topic '**Insights on post-graduate entrance and studying literature as a vocation**'. He is an RLAC alumni, currently pursuing M.Phil at the University of Delhi. The next by Ms. Neha Seotra on 'How To Use MLA Format' on 12th of February 2020 at 2 : 00 pm. The commerce department organised a certificate course on 'GST concepts and e filing' and invited an alumni Mr. Avdesh Vashishth as a speaker in that course.
