5. Language of research papers could be English or Hindi
6. Word limit of the paper will be between minimum 1500 words and maximum 2000 words.
7. 10-15 minutes will be given to each participant for the presentation of the paper
8. APA or MLA format of referencing will be used for citations in the text and at the end of the paper.
9. Paper should be written either in English or in Hindi.
10. Submit the entries along with the proof of payment of fees to the email address mentioned below.
